My practice centers on creating large-scale abstract sculptures from fabricated steel, engineered components, and reclaimed industrial materials. I'm drawn to embedded histories of found objects and the technical challenge of transforming heavy, functional materials into dynamic forms that animate their environments. My work is site-responsive and requires structural anchoring, rigging, and crane-assisted installation. With extensive experience placing durable outdoor works in civic, institutional, and public park settings, I integrate engineering and construction principles to produce sculptures that encourage community engagement, enhance their specific sites, and maintain long-term structural and visual integrity.
